Preparation	This antibody was produced from a hybridoma (mouse myeloma fused with spleen cells from a rat immunized with recombinant mouse TER-119). TER-119 Antigen is a molecule associated with cell-surface glycoprotein A).
Formulation and Storage	The IgG fraction of culture supernatant was purified by Protein G affinity chromatography and lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered solution in phosphate-buffered saline (PBS). Lyophilized samples are stable for 2 years from date of receipt when stored at -70°C.
Specificity	This antibody recognizes mouse TER-119 by direct ELISAs and WBs.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute the antibody with 500µl sterile PBS and the final concentration is 200µg/ml. Reconstituted antibody can also be aliquoted and stored frozen at <-20 for at least for six months without detectable loss of activity. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Shipping	Regular FEDEX overnight shipment (ambient temperature)
